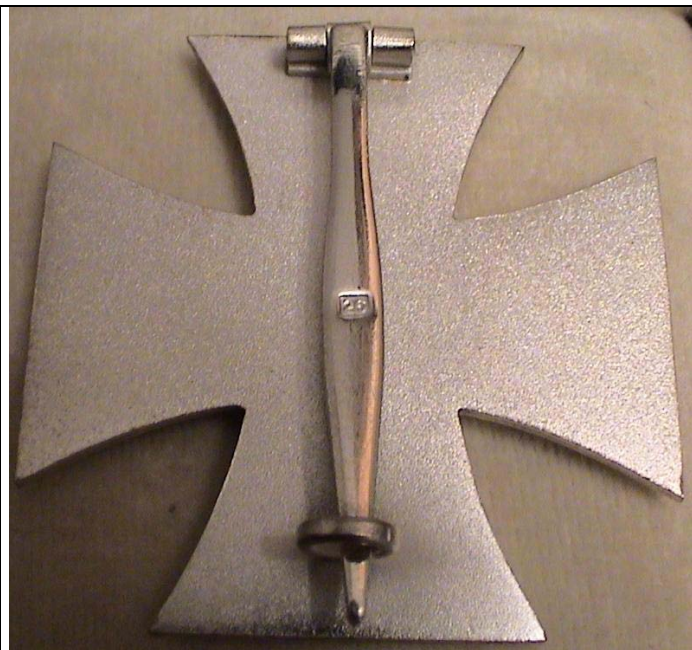


1939 Iron Cross First Class "26"
