

D.R.L. Sports Badge 2nd Model in Silver "Unmarked"

Description

The DRL Sports Badge 2nd Model (without Swastika) was instituted in 1934. It was issued in three grades (Bronze, Silver and Gold). They were presented (1934-1937). For the **Silver** they had to pass five parts of a physical test for a further eight years beyond the requirements of the Bronze grade. Or, if between 32 and 40, eligible if they passed the tests once in twelve months.

Remarks

This badge is very unusual in that it has the inside of the DRL lettering cut out. Normally the coke-bottle type pin setup badges have the solid center (non-cut out). Quite often these era DRL's are devoid of maker marks. The DRL in Silver (without Swastika) was awarded approximately 14,300 times.
